DESCRIPTION: A new introduction discovered in MN by Dennis Heins. An excellent tree for B&B growers because of its excellent branching habit and form in the nursery. Sienna will require less pruning and forms a well-branched tree, even as a young plant, and is a vigorous grower. It has excellent winter hardiness and has proved to be less susceptible to winter frost cracking, sun scald and dieback compared to Autumn Blaze®. The fall color is a consistent red to burgundy red. The smaller leaves and finer branching gives it a more delicate appearance in the landscape. Own root. (CÂ®)
